PARKER HANDICAP KNOCKOUT RULES

1 GAMES

Games will last for 40 minutes (including the knock up) and/or the best of five games, for all rounds. The player in the lead when time is called shall be declared the winner, if a winning game score is not reached.

2 SCORING

Point a rally (PAR) scoring to 15 points. If the game score reaches 14 all, **the next point is** sudden death.

<u>Note:</u> If games are level and scores are level at the end of time, the winner of the match will be the person who wins the next point. (If a rally is in progress when time is called, that rally shall be declared void. Hand-in from the void rally shall serve again.)

Time can only be paused during a match when either, the ball bursts' or the player asks for an injury timeout.

3 1st ROUND MATCHES

No markers will be provided for 1st round matches. If 1st round matches are not completed a toss of a coin will decide the player to go through to the 2nd round. Any difficulties arranging matches should be referred to competition organisers (Dan Carlile) for adjudication.

4 HANDICAP

Handicaps are to be interpreted as per the examples below:
